The grant is entitled, "Implementation of an HIV Status-Neutral Nurse-Led Intervention to Increase Equity in Clinical Outcomes for Male HIV Self-Testers in Tanzania." Previous research has shown that community-based care, including the provision of PrEP and ART, can help mitigate the various barriers that heterosexual men in Sub-Saharan Africa face when seeking HIV care in a traditional facility-based setting, thus exploring novel service-delivery settings for HIV care in Tanzania is critically import-
